Directions to the Amador County Fairgrounds

(also see <http://amadorcountyfair.com/Directions.aspx>)

FROM Interstate 80 (North of Sacramento) - Take I80 to Highway 50 East towards Placerville. Take the El Dorado Hills/Latrobe Exit. Turn left at the STOP sign on Latrobe Rd. Follow Latrobe Road to Highway 16. Turn left on Highway 16 towards Plymouth. See final directions below.

FROM Highway 99 (South of Sacramento) - Take Highway 99 North toward Sacramento. In Galt take Highway 104/Twin Cities Road to Lone(Jackson). Once you get into the town of lone, look for a "Sierra Trading Post" (convenience store) on the left corner of Highway 104 & Highway 124. Go left on Highway 124 to Plymouth. Then right on Highway 16 towards Plymouth. See final directions below.

FROM Highway 88 (out of Stockton) - Take Highway 88 North towards Jackson. Turn left on Highway 124 to lone. Follow Highway 124 into town. At the STOP sign on Main Street turn left. At the Bank of Amador (on right) and the bridge turn right, that is Highway 104/Preston Ave. Go to Highway 124, look for a "Sierra Trading Post" (convenience store) and turn right to Plymouth. Go right on Highway 16 to Plymouth. See final directions below.

WHEN entering town of Plymouth on Highway 16, look for the "Far Horizon, 49'er Trailer Park" on the left. Just after the entrance will be Empire Street, turn left. Go to the STOP sign. Turn left on Locus Street The entrance to the fairgrounds is straight ahead.
