- 8. Sifted animals may be sold at private treaty, but such sales must go through the sale clerk, who will complete the transaction as if conducted in the auction.
- 9. Registration certificates and transfers will be mailed to the breed association immediately after the sale when all deposits clear and will be returned to the buyers after transfer.
